

ORDINANCE NO 10

An ordinance to establish the grade and designate the manner of construction of sidewalks in the Village of Finlayson, Minnesota.

The common council of the Village of Finlayson does ordain:

Section 1: That the established grade of sidewalk in the Village of Finlayson shall be as follows:

All sidewalks shall be built of such material and width as the village council may from time to time direct. Not less than six inches above the center of the street opposite it and not more than twelve inches higher than the center of the street directly opposite such walk

Section 2: Whenever such walks are built of wood, it shall be constructed of good lumber of the width and thickness so ordered, in good workman like manner, laid to right angles with set of stringers laid parallel with the course of the street and not less three in number of solid foundation well secured on each bearing with twenty penny nails. The front stringer placed two inches from the outer edge next to the street.

Section 3: All sidewalks not build according to the order of the village council are hereby deemed public obstructions of the streets of said village and by an order of the council may be moved as such.

Section 4: this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
