

ORDINANCE NO 13

Relating to assisting officers in the execution of the office. The village council of the Village of Finlayson does ordain:

Section 1: That whoever being required by any marshal, sheriff, or constable, neglect to assist him in the execution of their office in any criminal or in the preservation of the peace or the apprehending or securing of any person for a breach of the peace or in any case of escape or rescue of persons arrested upon civil process, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding twenty five dollars nor less than five dollars, or be imprisoned in the village jail for not more than thirty days, nor less than five days at the discretion of the justice court of said village.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in force immediately on and after its passage.
