## ORDINANCE NO 18

An ordinance relating to pool table license and prescribing the conditions upon which may be granted.

The common council of the Village of Finlayson, State of Minnesota, County of Pine does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That license shall be granted for the keeping for public use of billiard and pool tables upon application being made to the Village Council. No bond will be required for such license.

Section 2: Upon such application being made the Village Council may direct the Village Recorder to issue a license in conformity to the application, upon the applicant paying the recorder a sum to be designated by the village council for each and every table per year so kept for public use and every such license issued shall expire with the last day of September next succeeding the issuing of same.

Section 3: Whoever shall keep any billiard or pool tables for public use without first having complied with Section 1 and 2 of this ordinance and without a proper license therefore shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty five dollars for each and every offense and in case the party so fined refuses or neglects to pay the same shall be committed to the county jail not exceeding sixty days or until such fine is paid.

Section 4: In case any one person is found guilty of breaking any of the provisions of this ordinance, the cost of prosecution shall in all cases be added to the fine or penalty.
