

ORDINANCE NO 3

An ordinance to prevent and restrain the common council from granting or issuing more than one license to sell intoxicating liquors in the Village of Finlayson for the ensuing year.

The common council of the Village of Finlayson, Pine County, Minnesota does ordain as follows:

That it shall be unlawful for the common council of the Village of Finlayson to grant or issue more than one license to sell intoxicating liquors for the ensuing year.

Any councilman violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars, nor more than one hundred dollars and costs of prosecution or by imprisonment in county jail for not less than ten days, nor more than ninety days.

This ordinance to be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
