Ordinance No 4

An ordinance to prevent and prohibit the piling or placing of cordwood, stove wood, lumber, or other material along the highways in the corporate limits of the Village of Finlayson.

The common council of the Village of Finlayson, pine County, Minnesota in regular session assembled, does ordain as follows:

That it shall hereafter be unlawful for any person to pile, place, or deposit any cord wood, stove wood, lumber, or other material along any of the highways in the corporate limits of the Village of Finlayson, Pine County, Minnesota.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished upon conviction thereof by imprisonment in the county jail for not less than ten days nor more than ninety days or by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars and not less than five dollars, and the cost of prosecution.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
