

ORDINANCE NO 9

Relative to the obstruction of streets by railroad trains or otherwise. The common council of the village of Finlayson does ordain:

Section 1: No railroad company nor their agents or employees nor any other persons or person shall obstruct any public street or highway in said village with locomotives, cars, freight, ties, etc, nor in any way obstruct the free passage for vehicles and passengers through the public highways, grounds, streets, or alleys of said village for any longer period than ten minutes at any one time, nor shall any railroad company or corporation, their officers, servants, agents or employees be permitted to stop train of cars or car, locomotive on any street or crossing, except in case of accident, for any longer time than ten minutes.

Section 2: Any person, company or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50.00) no less than five (\$5.00) dollars for each and every offense.

Section 3: Any provision in ordinance number four (4) of this village not consistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
